The position is a leadership opportunity for a detail orientated, mechanically inclined manager in a highly competitive underground construction industry. This is a critical role as it directly correlates to continually improving business efficiency and safety.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee and optimize shop performance in repair and maintenance operations for all fleet; work with company owned and contract shops to reduce cycle time and cost while ensuring quality workmanship.
- Establish processes, procedures and systems of measurement to deliver high service levels and effective maintenance management.
- Develop and direct all aspects of the mechanical operation and function of equipment and vehicles. Equipment must be maintained in safe, reliable, and cost-effective mechanical condition.
- DOT background in compliance and regulations.
- Study and recommend to management mechanical and quality standards in order to meet
 planned fleet operation and maintenance costs on a life cycle basis. Responsibilities also include
